


Males 49.5%





## Age Dependency Ratios




For every 1 adult aged 18 to 64, there are 0.44 persons under the age of 18.



*Number of people who commute from place of residence to place of primary employment*





















**Percent of the Adult Population age 25 and older with a high school education or higher**




**Percent of the Adult Population age 25 and older with a Bachelor's Degree or higher**


Persons reporting poverty based on education level




Individuals who attain higher levels of education typically earn more income, which is seen in the earnings by education.


