
#### TOTAL POPULATION CHANGE



#### Summary

Centre County's population grew nearly twice as fast as Pennsylvania's population, but lags by 1% behind the United State's population growth rate. Median age across all three geographies increased. The County's median age increased the most, by 1.2 years, but still remains the youngest due to the Penn State University student population. The ratio of youth to adults was nearly equal across all geographies, but the senior ratio varied in comparison. The percent of males to females was not statistically significant, but the County has a slightly higher percentage of males versus females. The County's population by race is nearly homogenous with over 98% of the population reporting one race described as White. At the state and national level, more racial diversity is reported.
