## MID-STATE REGIONAL AIRPORT

**Location:** Airport Road, off State Route 504, Rush Township

**Contact Information:** Authority of CC, 451 Airport Road,  
Philipsburg, PA 16866

**Acres:** 484.98 (both parcels combined)

**Building:** Main office building and terminal is over 5,000 square feet and is graded B by the Centre County Tax Assessment Office. Other structures include a warehouse and garage.

**Zoned:** No zoning.

**Public Water:** No.

**Public Sewer:** No.

**Current use:** Underutilized.

**Past use:** The Mid-State Regional Airport services have steadily declined but the authority has expressed interest in redeveloping their business plan for the natural gas industry.

The Mid-State Regional Airport is located on Airport Road, south of Black Moshannon Road (State Route 504) in Rush Township.

If you reference the map below, the airport authority owns parcels 1 and 2, while parcels 3 and 4 are owned by individuals. The Mid-State Regional Airport Authority owns over 450 acres of land which contains several structures including airplane hangers, warehouses, and offices.

Parcel 1: Mid-State Regional Airport, TAX ID 5-10-44, 468.98 acres

Parcel 2: Mid-State Regional Airport, TAX ID 5-10-44C, 16.00 acres

Parcel 3: Douglas Harpster, TAX ID 5-10-44B

Parcel 4: Richard Perry, TAX ID 5-10-44A

Also note that the Federal Aviation Administration and the Pennsylvania State University are listed in the tax assessment records as owning and/or leasing buildings on the property.
