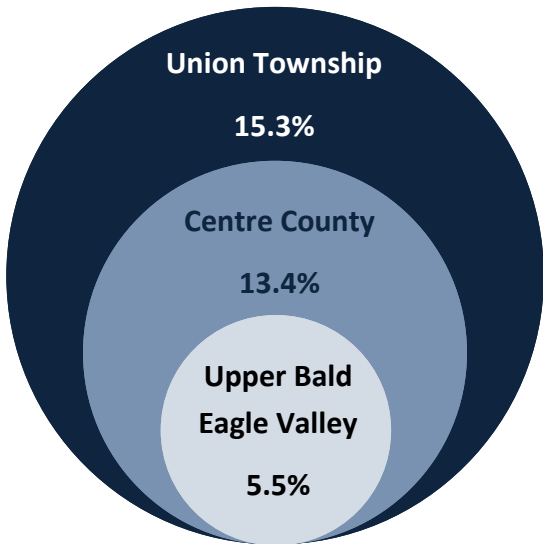

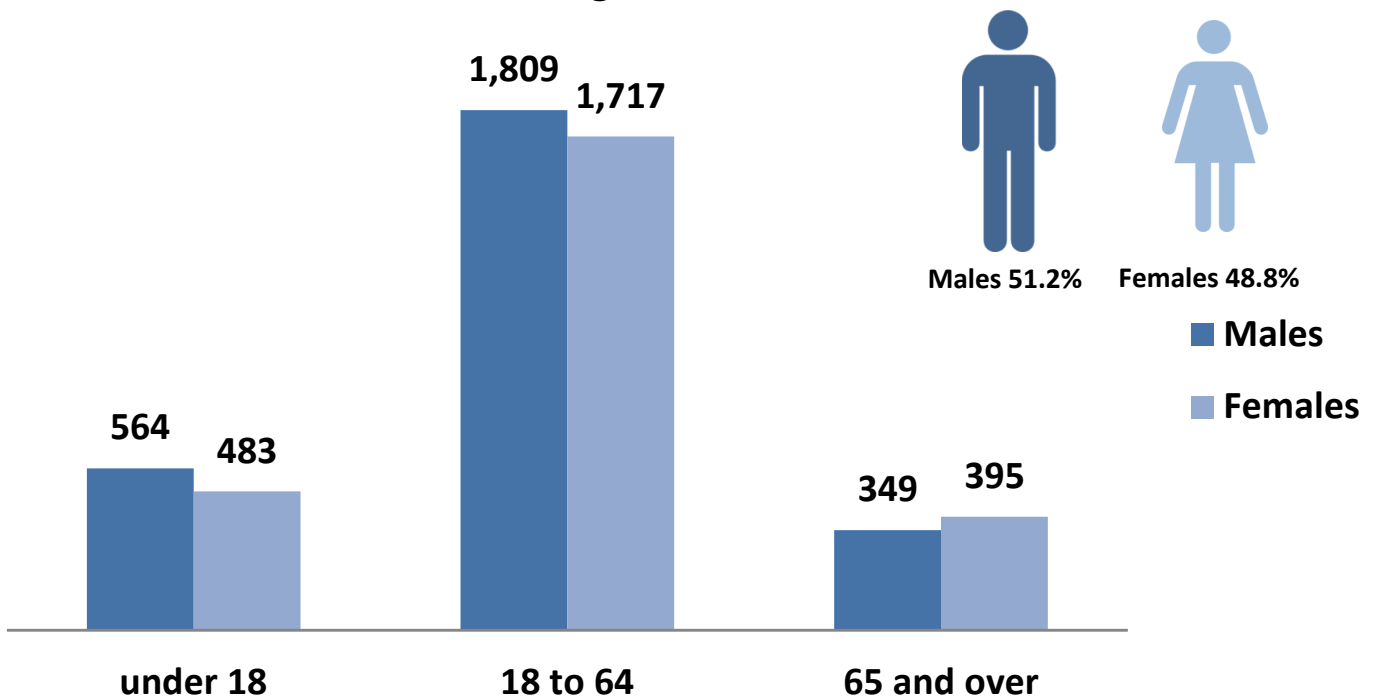

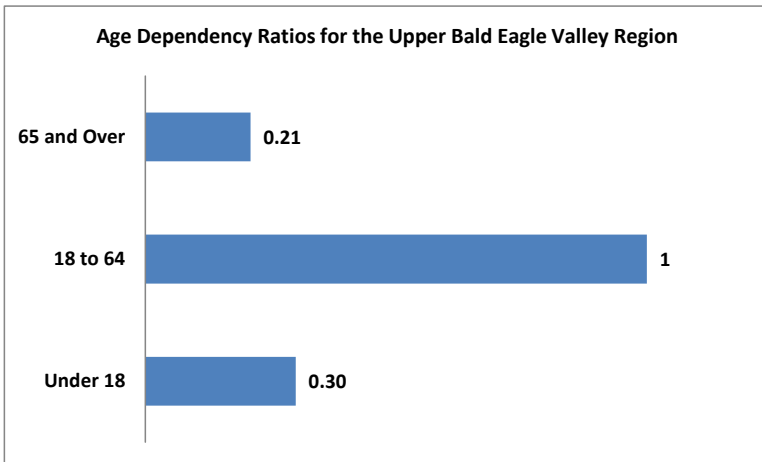
2010 Census Upper Bald Eagle Valley Population by Sex in Age Brackets

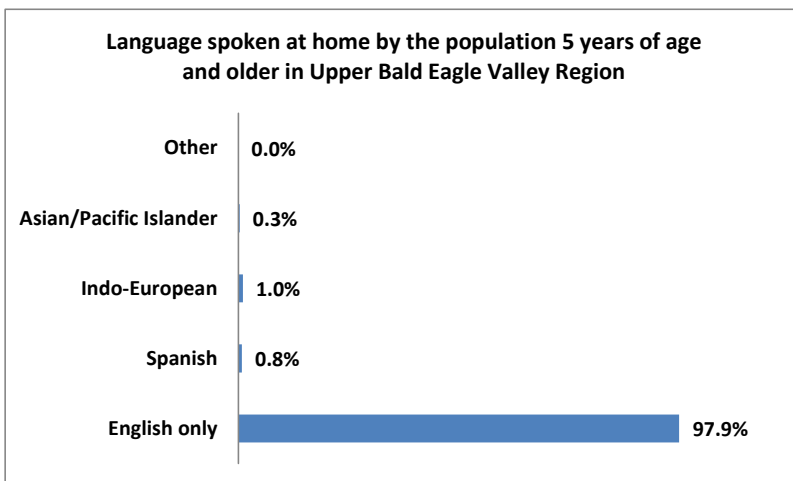


For every 1 adult aged 18 to 64, there are 0.30 persons under the age of 18.

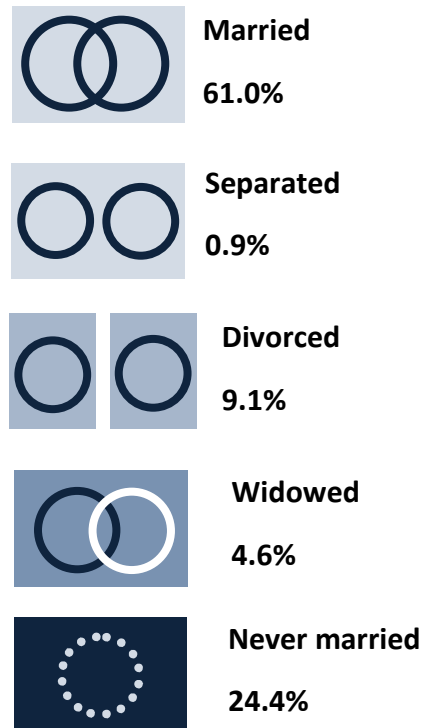
English proficiency among the population aged 5 years and older

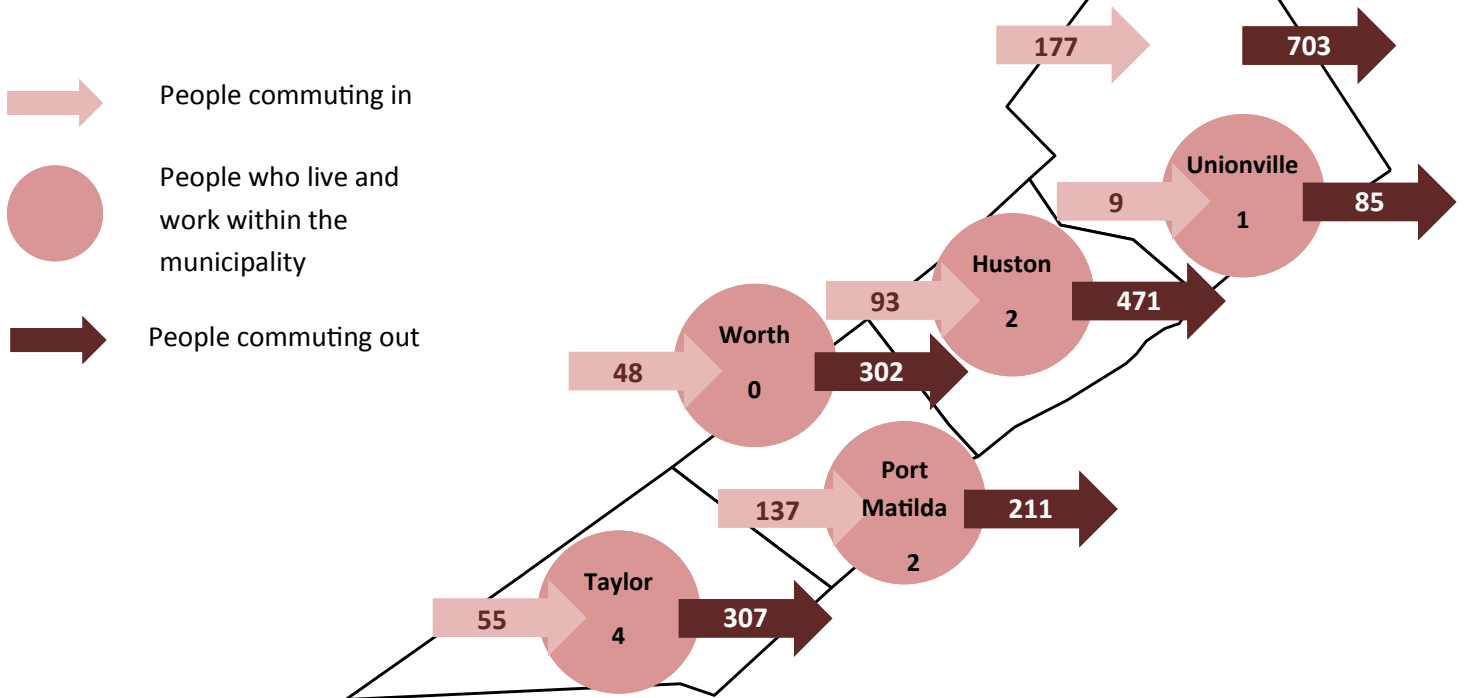

Number of people who commute from place of residence to place of primary employment



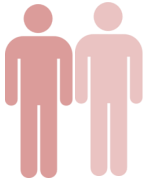

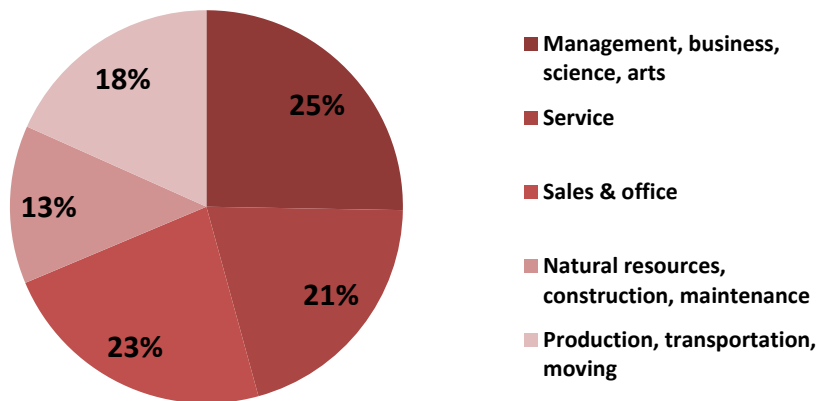

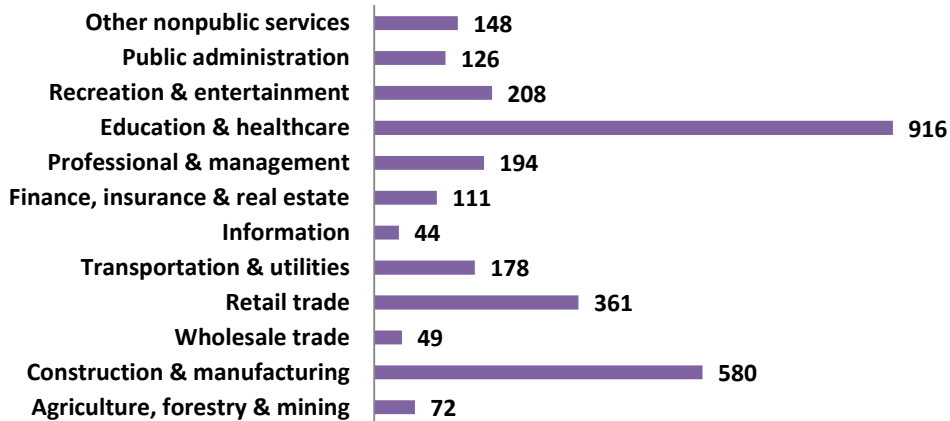

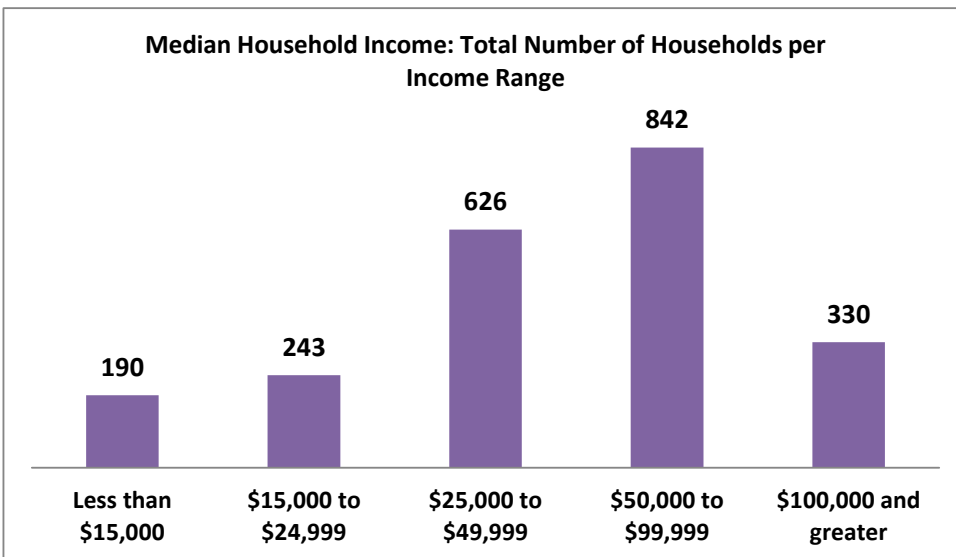
Employment by Industry Sector

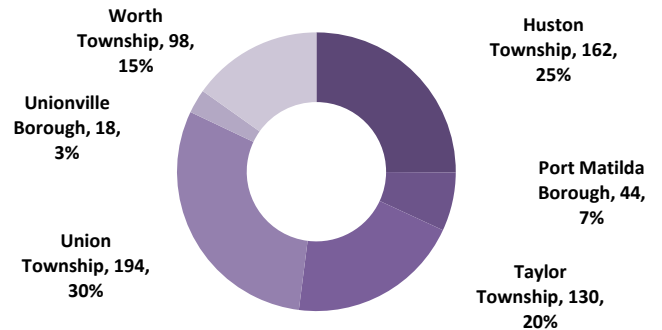

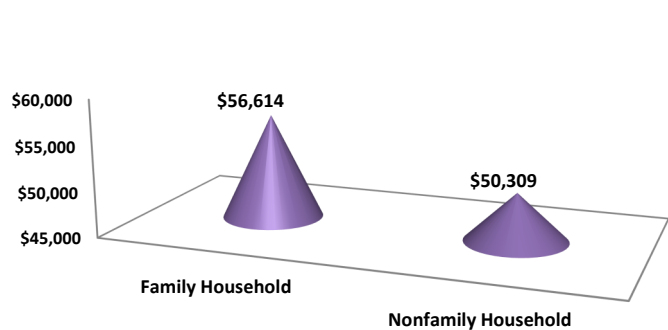

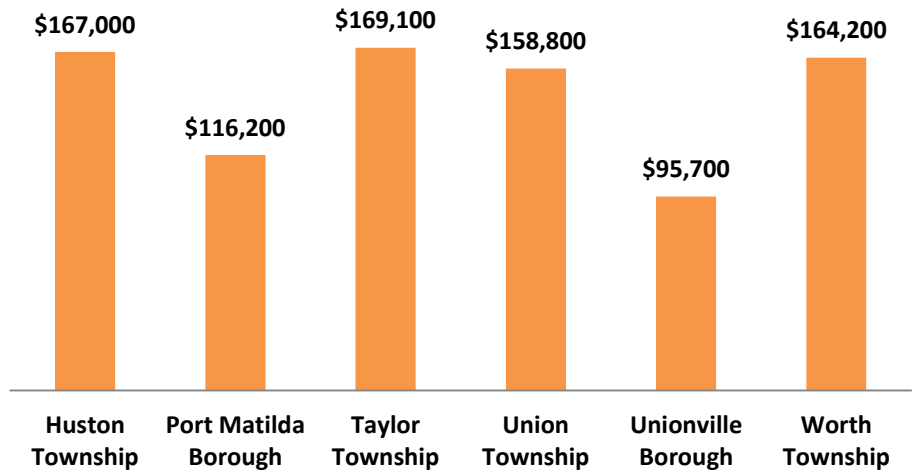

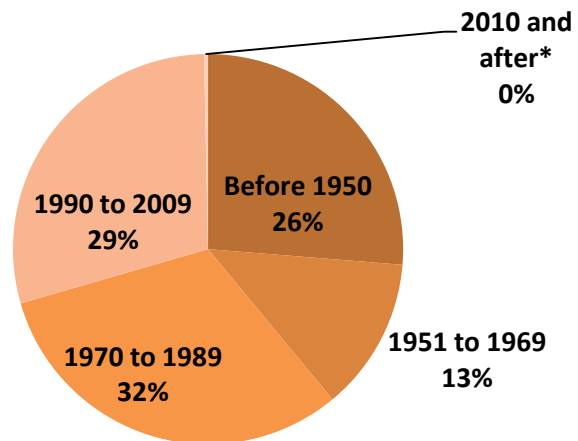

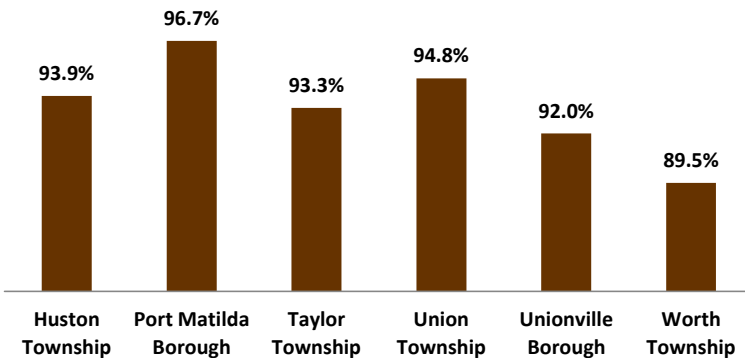

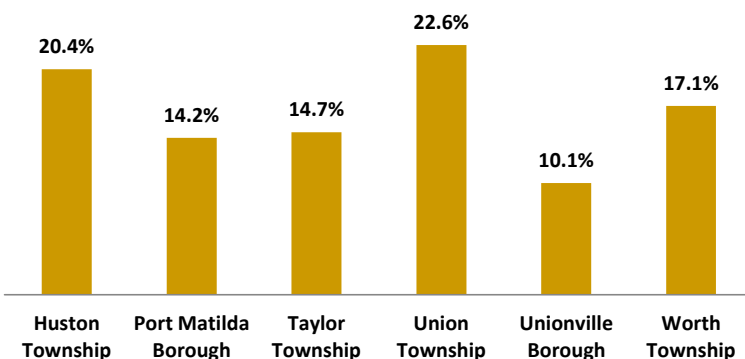

Percent of the Adult Population age 25 and over with a high school education or higher



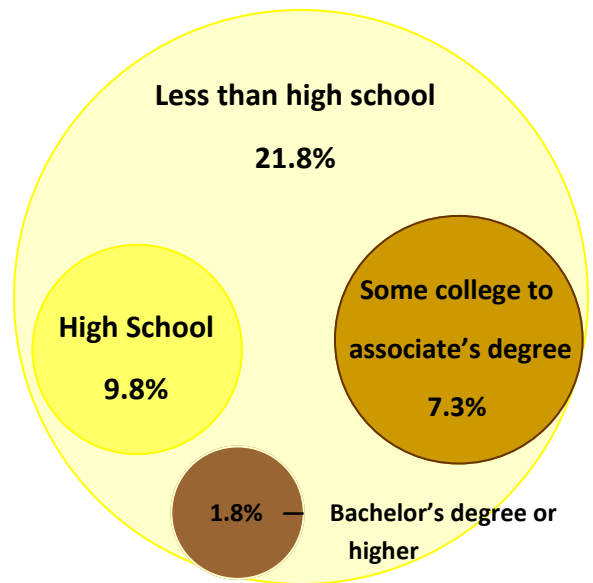
Percent of the Adult Population age 25 and over with a Bachelor's Degree or higher

For the adult population age 25 and over

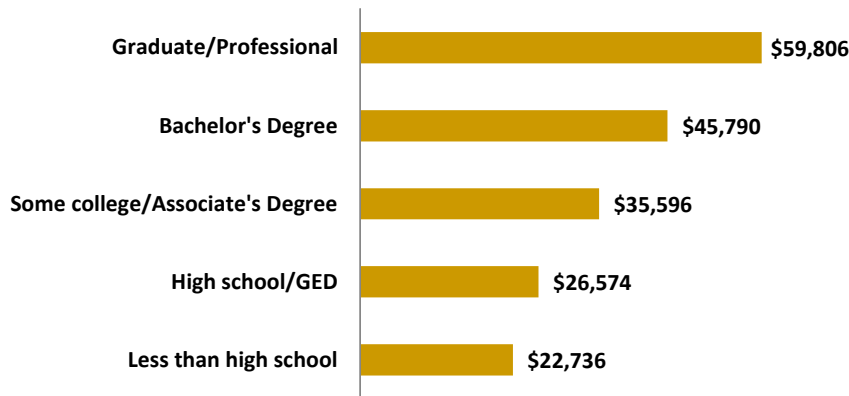
Persons reporting poverty based on education level

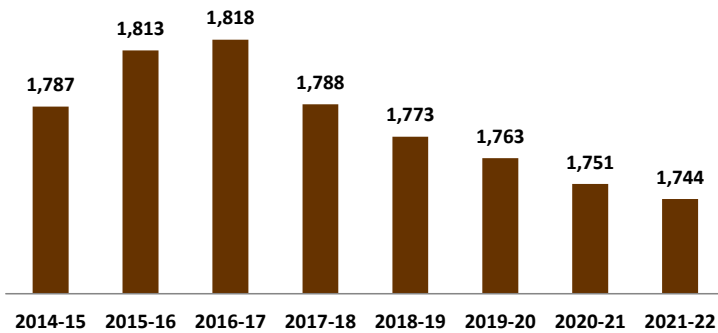
Education and Median Earnings



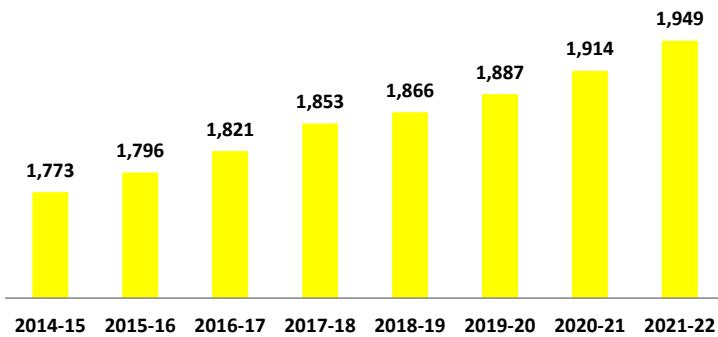
Individuals who attain higher levels of education typically earn more income, which is seen in the earnings by education.

Bald Eagle Area School District Enrollment Projections for Grades K to 12

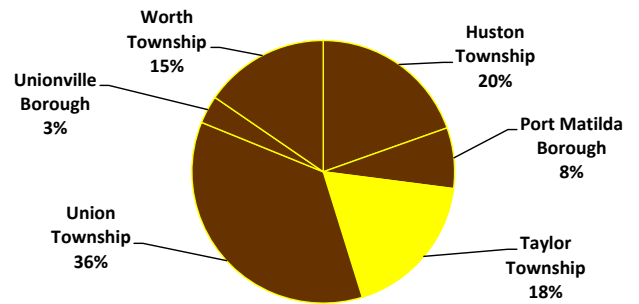


Tyrone Area School District Enrollment Projections for Grades K to 12

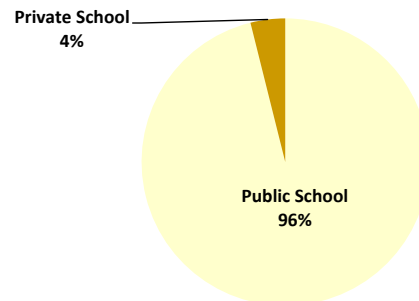


Enrollment projections for Bald Eagle Area School District are predicted to slowly decline while Tyrone Area's increases.
